## Guidelines for Submission of Abstracts of Papers and Posters

### Deadline for Submission ~ January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020

Abstracts of papers, posters, sessions, training workshops or plenary speakers should not exceed 250 words. They may be submitted in MS Word, WordPerfect or RTF formats. Abstracts should be formatted *as per the example below*). Use 12 pt Times New Roman font throughout, single line spacing, fully justified, with left and right margins of 2.5cm. The abstract title should be in title case (*principal words capitalized*) and in bold font. The author's given name or initials should precede the surname. The surname of the author who will lead the presentation should be in **bold**. The author's affiliation, city, province abbreviation and e-mail address should be in *italics*, with superscript numerals indicating affiliations for individual authors as required. All genus and species names should be in italics. At the end of the abstract please indicate your preferred presentation format: oral presentation, poster presentation, themed session (list presenters), panel discussion (list participants), training workshop (specify time and number of participants), no preference. Also indicate the e-mail address to which a notice of receipt and notice of acceptance should be sent.
